Comments

I understand that part of this class is about thinking critically about the media but attacking news organizations without taking into account what it's like from, say, a reporter's perspective is a little absurd.

The instructor demonstrated their bias quite often in class. Often times she was unwilling to accept and understand that people do not always share her opinions. It feels as though the only correct opinions are the ones that agree with her own.

I didnt like the group project.

Getting off topic (rare)

I did not like how hard it was to take notes and how zone discussions were separated because my partner did not want to talk with me. Maybe focus more on bigger class discussions so participation can be counted.

Her clarity. Assignments were always vague with an even vaguer deadline. As our major project was a large group assignment I thought it would be carefully planned out, but the assignment seemed to change constantly. Overall I would say the worst part was how class seemed to never accomplish much. I never left learning more than I did with a glance at the readings and the expectations for tests remained vague.

She needs to be more authoritative honestly. The room will respect her more in the future if she acts a little stronger.

Calling your students that are 4–5 years younger than you campers is just weird. In a class like this you want everyone to feel invited and welcomed not by creating a counselor/camper divide.

The group project was by far my least favorite part. The assignment itself was very interesting and helped to ground the course concepts in current and relevant topics, but coordinating with a group who was uninterested in the material and the project was difficult

The format of lecture, I felt confused a lot of the time leaving class

Nothing really.

The project was not nearly as good as the lectures. The assignment sheet was incomplete, and goals were not communicated to students. Points would be taken off for silly things that would be much easier to just communicate to the students. This leaves the students feeling frustrated and like their work is undervalued.

Sometimes the material was hard to understand and more clarity in would have been helpful. Some discussion questions in class were difficult to follow. Also deadlines were really tight for the final project so more turn around time would have been helpful.

Readings

I would say that the amount of readings given did seem overwhelming at times if they were paired with the summary assignment.

At times unorganized and confusing

What could the instructor do to improve the course or his/her teaching effectiveness?

Comments

To not be so blatantly bias when directing class discussion and/or material. It makes the students feel like they can't add to the conversation (this is coming from multiple students) also it just causes you to lose credibility in the eyes of your students. And talking to a group of 19–22yr olds like we are children is just really unnecessary.

Better visual aids. This includes power points. Consistency in using power points would be helpful instead of the use only every once in a while. Visual notes help us take better notes in class

Treat students like adults

Don't let the discussion go on indefinitely, but still encourage discussion.

The instructor could improve on using slides or powerpoint to highlight discussion of in class readings. It was difficult to discuss and note take when terms and subjects were being discussed rapidly with no organization.

Organization and actual teaching is key. Although the second part of the semester was an improvement, after class was over I felt as if I could have learned more from five miniutes of the readings than the hour and fifteen of lecture. Clarity is also important we would often hop back and forth and the important parts of a lesson were completely unknown. Overall, The Professor was great, but the teaching was not.

Improve lecture style and comfortability. This just comes with experience.

Treat her students more like people less like little kids

Some of the readings were a bit difficult to digest, especially in the beginning of the course when I had little previous experience reading very academic political pieces. As the course went on, it got easier, but I almost think perhaps starting the course with even just half a lecture on how to approach these kinds of articles may be helpful and might make them seem less daunting.

Go more in-depth with the readings and help explain it more, a lot of things were very confusing for me

She had us do a midterm evaluation and effectively implemented everything suggested such as more visuals, less breakdown of basic concepts, etc. The second half of the semester was great and highly effective.

The lectures are fine the way they are.

I felt that Professor Ferrillo too often made her political beliefs clear in discussion. I wish she was more definitively unbiased when running discussion.

More structured discussions and lectures would be helpful for me to better learn the material. The powerpoints at the end of the semester really started to help this.

More PowerPoint lecture for further understanding of content

More visual aids.
